DRESS CODE FOR THE CHRISTMAS PROGRAM

Dress rehearsal is during school next Friday, 12/15. All students participating in the Christmas program are expected to wear their "uniform" (details below) to school, and to bring a change of clothes. The musical shirts will be distributed during dress rehearsal.

Grades K-6: musical t-shirt, solid-colored dark long pants (black, brown, grey, navy, etc) with no visible holes or stains, shoes (not snow boots), students with long hair should have it up/back out of their faces. Girls, no undergarments should be visible through the pale shirts. No distracting jewelry.

Grades 5+ may wear makeup appropriate for their character with parent permission. Makeup is to be done at home and must be worn for dress rehearsal in order to be approved for the performance.
